WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE <u>BEHIND IN BOTH</u> DYNAMIC AND STATIC ELEMENTS:

If you have a <u>big</u> disadvantage in a Dynamic Element, but only a <u>small</u> disadvantage in a Static Element, then <u>do</u> trade pieces.

However, if you have only a <u>small</u> disadvantage in a Dynamic Element, but a <u>big</u> disadvantage in a Static Element, then do <u>not</u> trade pieces.
